- Learn to identify, record and escalate HHSRS (housing health and safety rating system) hazards to keep customers safe

- Develop and understanding of our asset management system, the decent homes standard and how are data plays a key role in compliance.
- There will be a requirement to meet at designated pick-up point/s to accompany on site visits
