Driven by curiosity and confidence, you'll explore data in depth, ask the right questions, and translate complex information into clear, actionable insight. While you'll use modern tools — such as Power BI and AI — to perform your analysis, your true impact lies in influencing others to act on your findings.

You'll play a key role in fostering a data-driven culture by making information accessible, reliable, and engaging. At the same time, you'll continue to grow your expertise in analytics and emerging technologies, helping shape the future of data within the organisation.

Driving Insight and Business Value

- Proactively engage with teams across the organisation to understand their goals, challenges, and data needs, ensuring reporting solutions are aligned with strategic priorities.
- Translate business questions into data-driven solutions that uncover trends, highlight opportunities, and inform decision-making.
- Contribute to the delivery of key data and performance services, including the performance framework and associated reporting - helping shape how success is measured and communicated.

Stakeholder Engagement and Collaboration

- Partner with stakeholders to gather and refine business requirements, offering expert guidance on best practices for report design and data storytelling.
- Communicate reporting changes clearly and confidently, providing training and support to ensure stakeholders can interpret and act on insights.
- Collaborate across teams and projects, applying a data lens to cross-functional initiatives and embedding analytics into everyday decision-making.

Data Knowledge and Technical Expertise

- Build deep knowledge of corporate systems, their underlying processes, and the data they generate to provide context-rich insights.

- Collaborate with subject matter experts and technical leads to document the full reporting lifecycle—from requirements gathering to delivery and ongoing maintenance.
- Act as a champion for modern reporting techniques, particularly using Power BI and AI-enhanced tools, driving continuous improvement in how data is used and understood.

Design and Delivery of Reporting Solutions

- Design and deliver scalable, efficient, and visually compelling dashboards, reports, and analytical solutions.
- Streamline reporting processes through automation and innovation, enhancing the speed, accuracy, and accessibility of insights.
- Ensure solutions are user-centric, intuitive, and tailored to the needs of diverse audiences across the organisation.

Documentation and Knowledge Sharing

- Create clear, comprehensive documentation to support the development, use, and maintenance of BI solutions.
- Share knowledge and best practices across the team and wider organisation, contributing to a culture of learning, collaboration, and data literacy.

- Strong analytical and critical thinking skills, with the ability to explore data deeply, identify patterns, and generate meaningful insight.
- Proven ability to use data visualisation tools (e.g., Power BI, Excel, Tableau) to present complex analysis in a clear, engaging, and accessible way for decision-makers.

Stakeholder Engagement and Communication

- Proven experience of gathering requirements from stakeholders, including the ability to elicit key information, challenge assumptions, and clarify business needs.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to confidently engage with both technical and non-technical audiences.
- Strong listening and influencing skills, with the ability to build trust, manage expectations, and guide stakeholders toward effective data solutions.

Technical Capability and Solution Delivery

- Demonstrable experience of delivering dashboard and reporting solutions with a focus on usability and scalability rather than technical depth.
- Ability to use modern tools and techniques to deliver scalable, repeatable, and efficient reporting solutions.
- Experience of manipulating and analysing complex, cross-organisational data using relevant tools (e.g., Excel, including pivot tables and lookup formulas).

- Ability to manage own workload, plan effectively, and deliver work to agreed timescales and standards.
- Comfortable working independently and collaboratively across teams and projects.

- Willingness to embrace change and contribute to organisational and cultural transformation.
